Outstanding Thesis and Dissertation Awards

Every year, Graduate School Deans and the Thesis Office select excellent theses and dissertations and submit them to thesis and dissertation competitions held nationally by the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS) and regionally by the Western Association of Graduate Schools (WAGS). Nominees from the U are awarded a cash prize by the Graduate School and have the opportunity to compete for a \$2,000 award.

Manuscript Consultation

Graduate students writing their dissertations or theses are encouraged to visit the Thesis Office early in their writing process to learn proper formatting techniques. Learning the acceptable formatting for publication before the defense means students can rest easy knowing the publishing process should proceed on schedule. Consultations are available the first two months of each semester.
